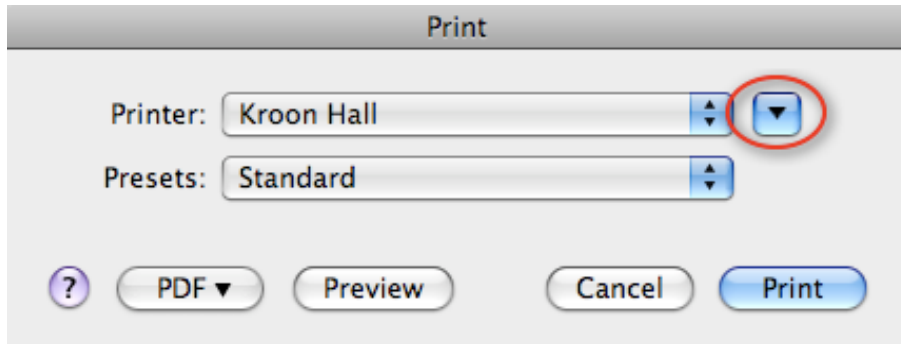
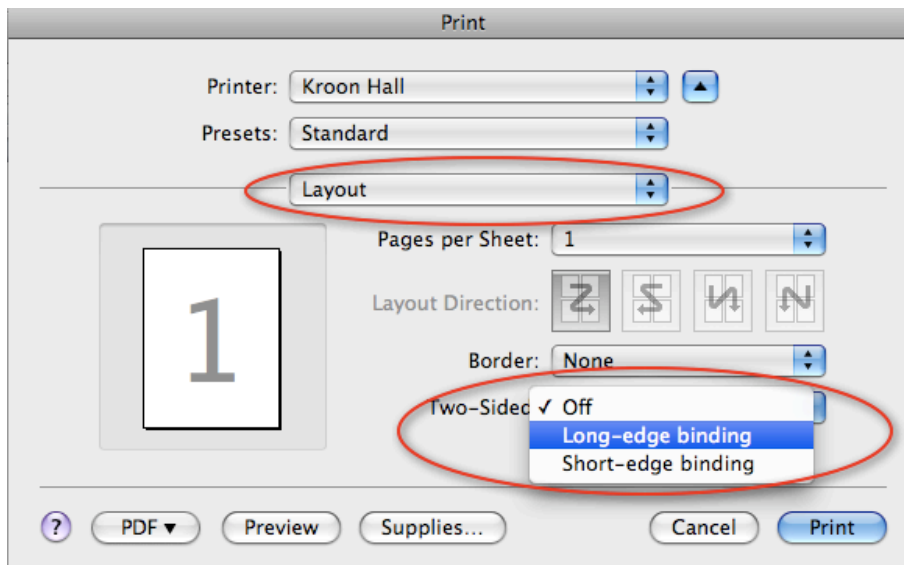


Saving Printer Settings in OS X 10.5 : Duplex and B&W Printing

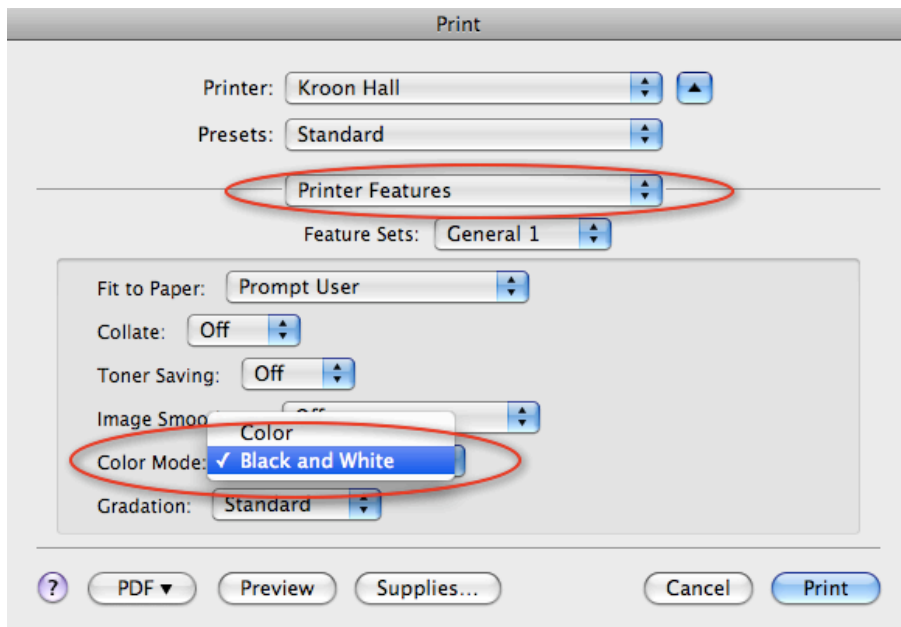
1. Open a document to print and select "Print" to open the print dialog window.
2. If the Print dialog contains only two pop-up menus and some buttons across the bottom, click the disclosure triangle beside the Printer pop-up menu.



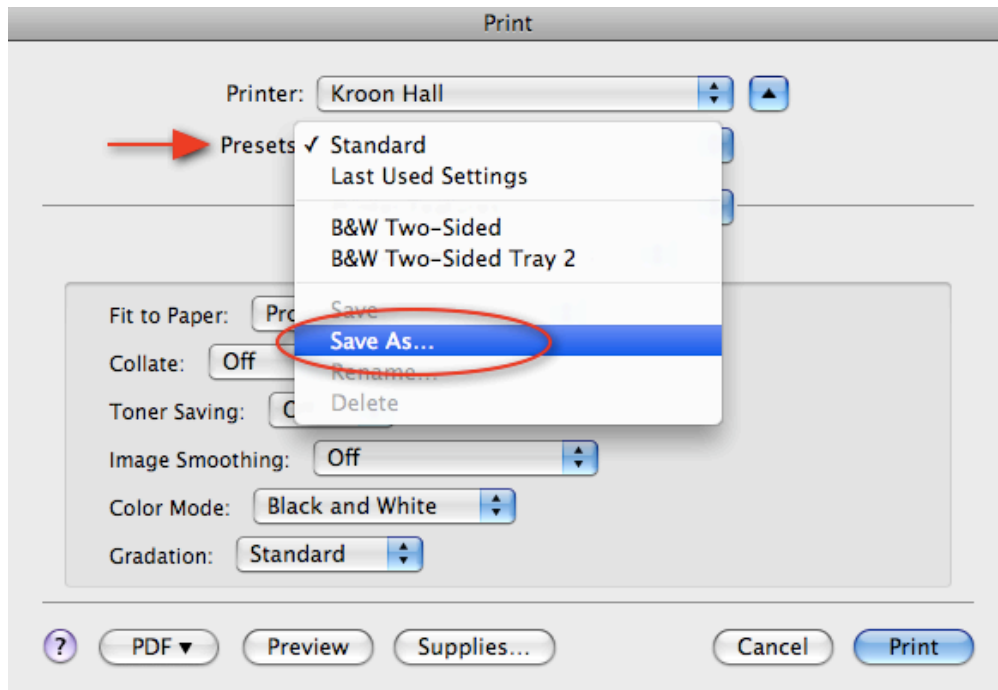
3. To print duplex or two-sided, select "Layout" from the print options pop-up menu. Select long- or short-edge binding.



- To print in Black & White, select “Printer Features” from the print options pop-up menu. Select “Black and White” for the color mode option.



- To save these options, select “Save As...” from the Preset pop-up menu. Type a description (ex. “B&W Two-Sided”) and click save.



- In general, OS X 10.5 will remember your selected preset but you should verify this each time you print.
